

# ALIA Multicultural Terms of Reference

ALIA Multicultural aims to facilitate networking, support professional development, and resources for the Information sector with a focus on Culturally and Linguistically Diverse communities.

#### Purpose:

The ALIA Multicultural Group was formed as a cross-sector group committed to advocacy and awareness of diversity and inclusion in the information sector and building connections with multicultural communication personnel.

#### Key areas of focus include:

- Information sharing of research and best-practice.
- Advocacy for improved diversity and inclusion in the workforce including strong leadership pathways.
- Access to professional development and support across sectors for diversity focussed professionals.
- Advocacy for improved services for multicultural communities and building on pathways to enhance the experience of multicultural people using the libraries and information services.
- Professional development with a focus on Multicultural needs

### Who can be involved:

ALIA Multicultural is open to anyone eligible for ALIA membership including LIS professionals and students studying LIS courses in Australia and via institutional membership.
